

## Curriculum Overviews

At Micklefield we provide a stimulating, enjoyable and challenging curriculum and we aim to enable all children to learn and develop their skills to the best of their ability. We understand that each child is special and unique and therefore these overviews are offered as a general guide.

### Early Years Foundation Stage (Preps and Reception)

The curriculum for children in Preps and Reception is organised as seven inter-connected areas of learning and development.

The three prime areas are:

- Communication and Language
- Physical Development
- Personal, Social and Emotional Development.

The four specific areas are:

- Literacy
- Mathematics
- Understanding the World
- Expressive Arts and Design.

### Key Stages 1 & 2 (Years 1-6)

The curriculum for children in Years 1 to 6 is organised by subject:

- Core subjects: English, Mathematics and Science:
- Foundation subjects: Art & Design, Computing, Design & Technology, French, Geography, History, Music and Physical Education
- Religious Education: based on the Agreed Syllabus for Religious Education in Surrey Schools
- Personal, Social, Health and Economic education (PSHE).

Please note that the Agreed Syllabus for Religious Education in Surrey Schools has been up-dated for 2017-2022. These jigsaws will be adjusted accordingly each year to ensure progression & continuity for all pupils.
